1) GET 'EM HERE FIRST (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Two acts currently climbing the countdown make their mark with some chart history firsts. There's the first Christian heavy metal band to ever hit the Top 40—the 4-man band from Orange County called Stryper—with their hit "HONESTLY." We also have the first female Rap group to ever hit the survey—Salt-N-Pepa, from New York City, with their hit "PUSH IT." Get all the chart firsts, first, on American Top 40.

2) HOLLYWOOD'S COMIN' AT US (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem, and you know I usually say we're comin' to you from Hollywood, well, now we have Hollywood comin' at us. In the countdown we've got two hot hits from two very hot movie stars. Patrick Swayze, the star of the movie, "DIRTY DANCING" is singing with Wendy Fraser on "SHE'S LIKE THE WIND." 3) COMIN' AND GOIN' WITH BELINDA AND GEORGE (:24)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Here in the survey, we've got two big stars --rising and falling. Belinda Carlisle fell out of the survey last week with her #1—"HEAVEN IS A PLACE ON EARTH." But, she picked up the slack, debuting with her new one called, "I GET WEAK." Then, there's George Michael, falling with his #1, "FAITH", while he's climbing with his follow-up—"FATHER FIGURE." Belinda and George—everywhere you look—on American Top 40.

4) ROWDY ROTH'S ROCKIN' RETURN (:23)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem, and look who's set to "jump" back in the survey. He's just a Gigolo, but everybody knows he can rock 'n roll with the best of 'em—Diamond David Lee Roth's returned. The rowdy Roth's climbing the chart with the first hit from his new album, "Skyscraper." The song is "JUST LIKE PARADISE." And if we know David, he's hopin' to debut with a Garden of Earthly delights—on American Top 40.

5) INXS SUCCESS (:19)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. In the Rock Era, four Australian acts—acts born or formed down under—have hit #1 up here in the U.S.A. Well, we could have a fifth, 'cause those six guys from Sydney, INXS, sailed to #2 last week with their smash "NEED YOU TONIGHT." INXS are lookin' for success—on American Top 40
