IN HOUR II THERE ARE TWO THIRTY-SECOND SPOTS: C-2 AND C-5

IN HOUR III THERE ARE TWO THIRTY-SECOND SPOTS: C-2 AND C-5

IN HOUR IV THERE ARE TWO THIRTY-SECOND SPOTS: C-2 AND C-4

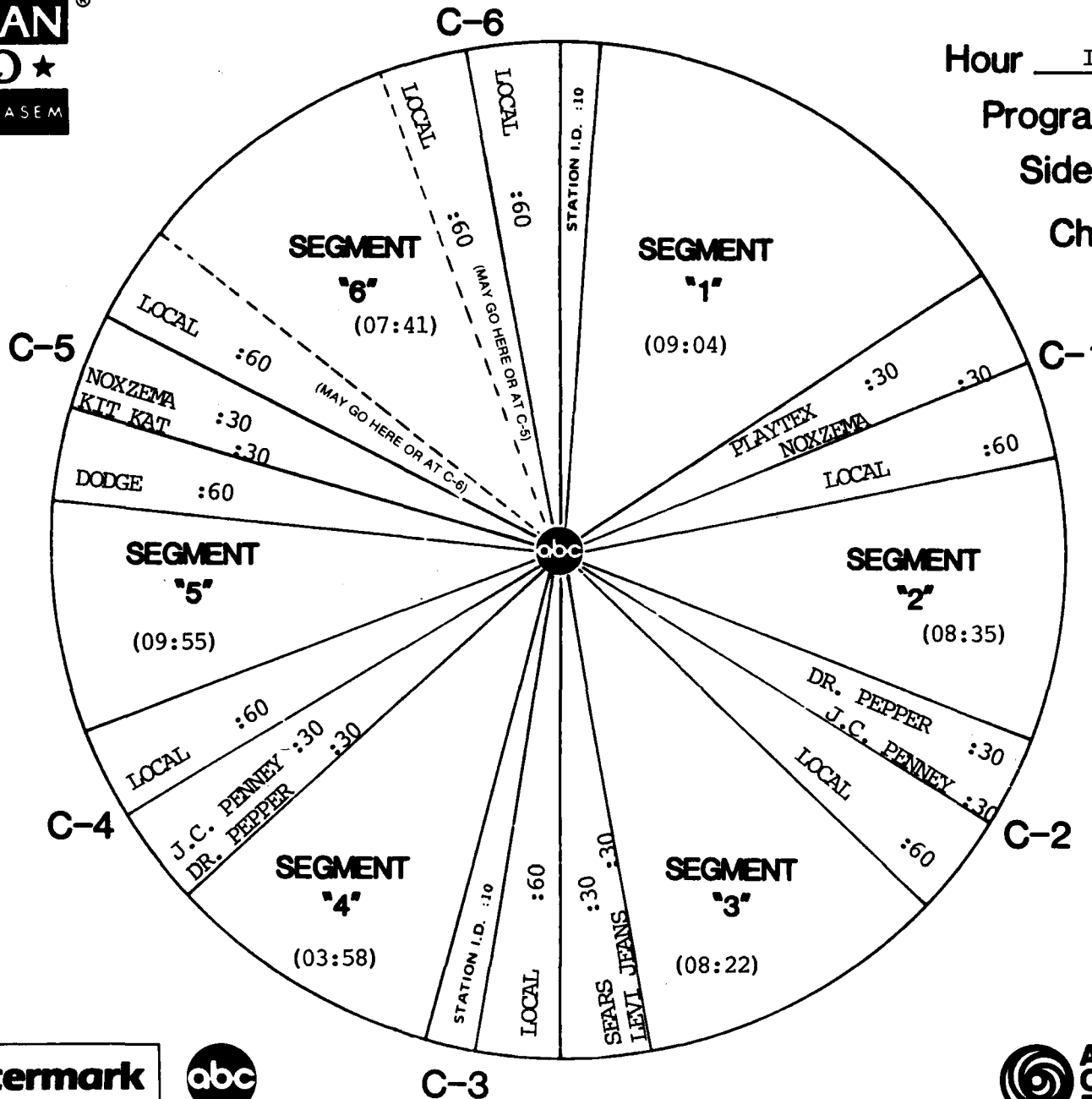

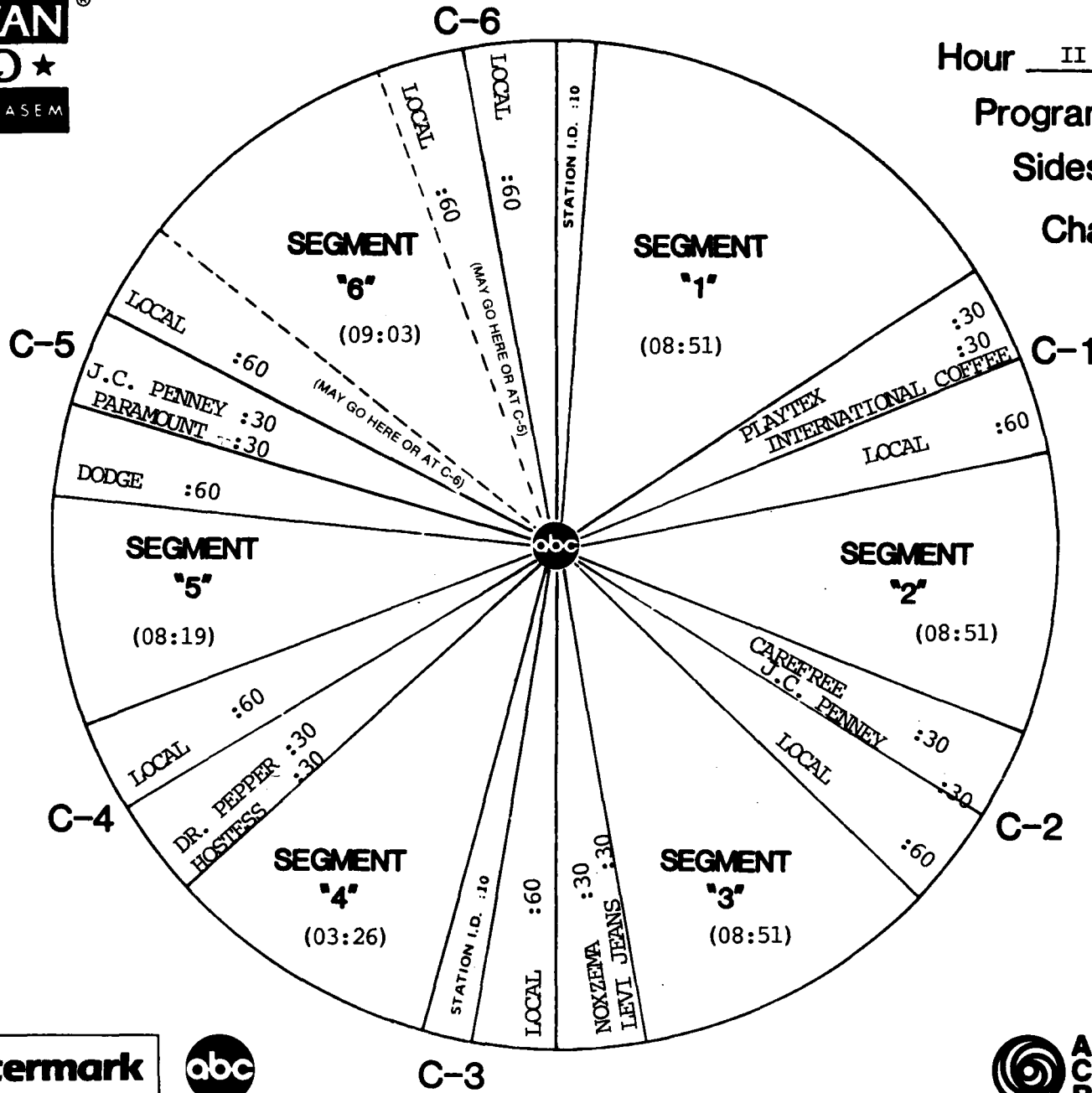

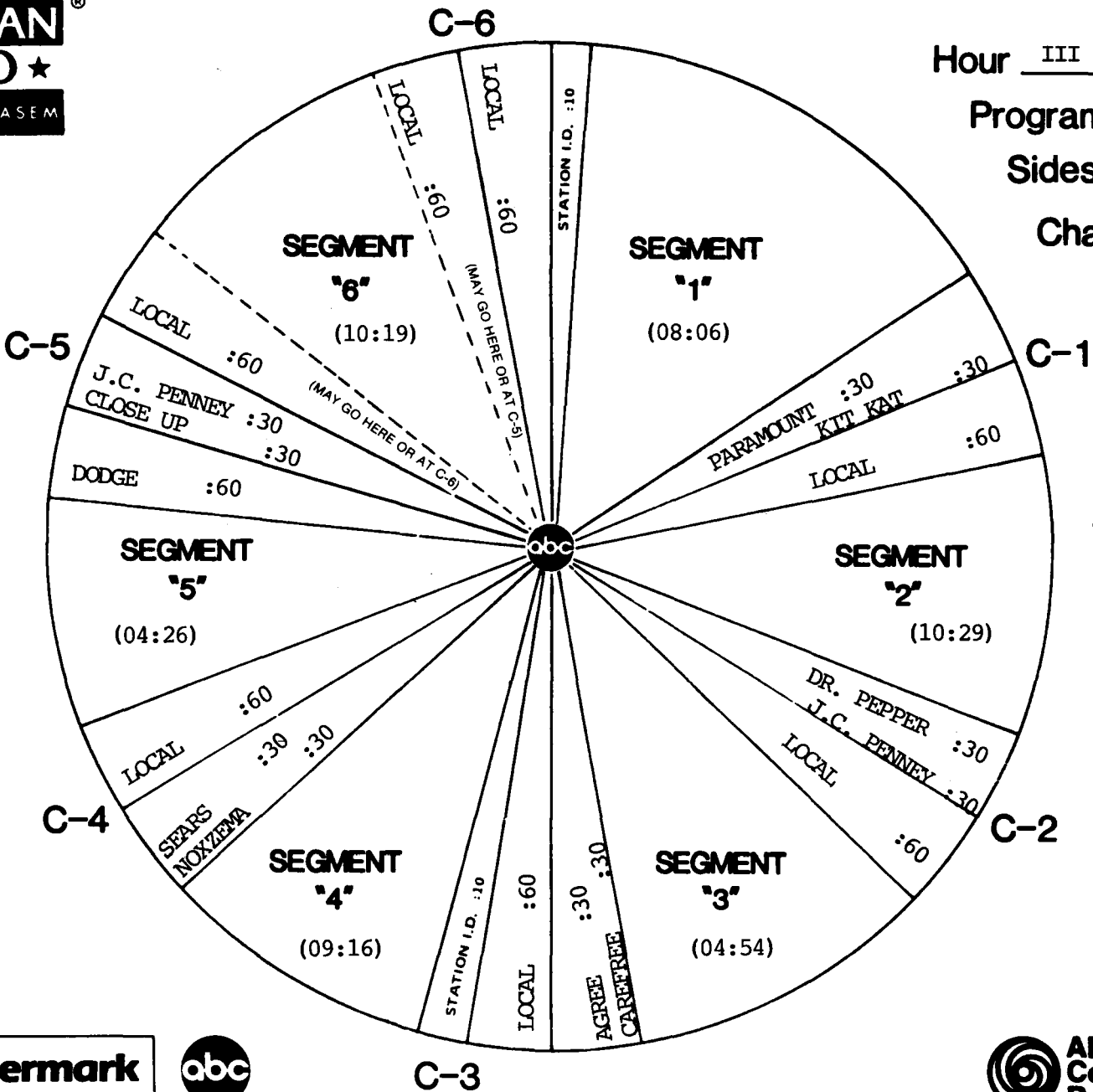

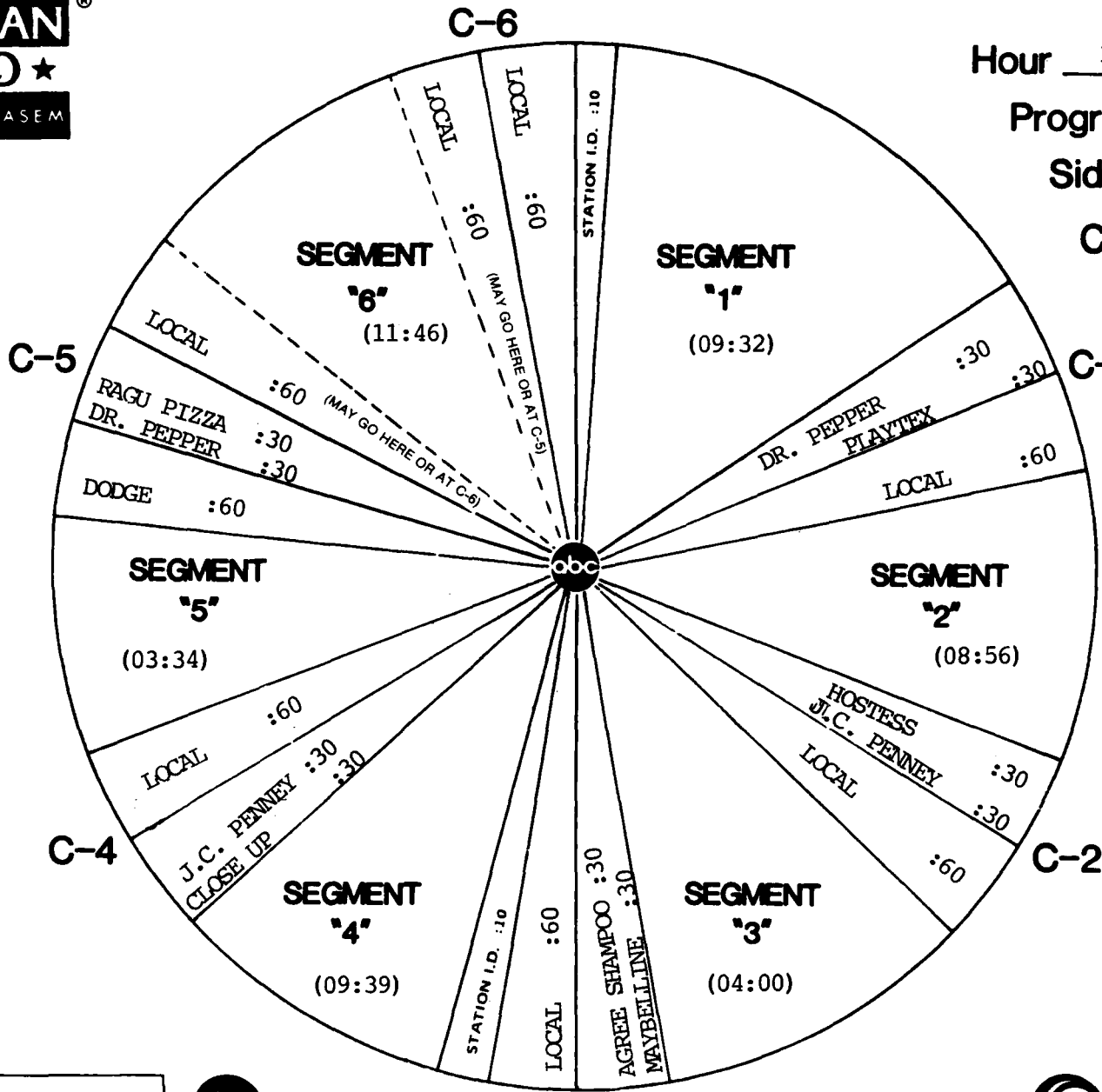

1) NUMBER ONE MAN (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Who's the #1 man in the countdown? Well, his album, "Faith", recently climbed back into the #1 spot on the album chart. The last two hits from that album, "FAITH" and "FATHER FIGURE", both hit #1 on the Billboard Pop Survey. And now his latest hit "ONE MORE TRY" is at #2 and has Number One written all over it. Will George Michael collect one more #1? We'll find out as we count 'em down this week on American Top 40.

2) THE OTHER BRUCE (:27)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last year, Bruce Hornsby and The Range released their first album. Most people thought it didn't have much of a pop sound, including Bruce himself. Well, everybody was wrong. The album generated three Top 40 hits, including the #1 "THE WAY IT IS." Now Bruce brings us more of his new found sound on a second album called "Scenes from the Southside." And the album's first hit "THE VALLEY ROAD" is travelling up the countdown. Follow Bruce's pop path on American Top 40.

3) AUSSIE SENSATION (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. And we've definitely found some New Thunder from Down Under. A six man band from Sydney, Australia have taken the Official Billboard Chart by storm scoring with two smashes, the #1 "NEED YOU TONIGHT" and the #2 "DEVIL INSIDE." Now their fast moving latest hit, "NEW SENSATION" looks like it's going to debut in the countdown this week. INXS are the New Ozzie Sensation shakin; our nation on American Top 40.
