## TOPICAL PROMOS

AT40 PROMOS FOR SHOW #862-13 ARE LOCATED AT THE END OF 4A

1' CAN JETS FLY OVER OCEAN? (:26)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Patti LaBelle and Michael McDonald spent a second week at number one with "ON MY OWN." But right below, ready to muscle into that top spot, are two other hot hits. At number two there's Billy Ocean's ballad, "THERE'LL BE SAD SONGS." And at number three, the new family act, the Jets, with "CRUSH ON YOU." Who'll be at number one on this week's survey? We'll find out when we count down the official Billboard chart on American Top 40.

2) JANET'S JUMPIN (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, Janet Jackson hit number one on the Soul chart with her second big hit, "NASTY." And on the Pop chart, that hot hit of hers leaped ten notches to number 14. It'll be a surprise if it doesn't become her second top ten Pop hit. Janet Jackson's "in control." But whatever she does, we'll know about it -- on American Top 40.

3) PICKS TO CLICK (:22)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. There's a handful of hot songs on the Billboard chart with Top 40 potential: "SECRET SEPARATION" by the Fixx, "WE DON'T HAVE TO TAKE OUR CLOTHES OFF" by Jermaine Stewart, "YOU SHOULD BE MINE (THE WOO WOO SONG)" by Jeffrey Osborne, and "HYPERACTIVE" by Robert Palmer. Any or all of 'em could be active in the Billboard countdown this week--on American Top 40.

4) CHART CHECK-UP (:28)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, these hot records topped the Billboard charts: the number one Soul song, "NASTY," by Janet Jackson. The number one Country song "MAMA'S NEVER SEEN THOSE EYES," by the Forester Sisters. The number one album-- "Whitney Houston." And the number one Pop song was the smash duet by Patti LaBelle and Michael McDonald, "ON MY OWN." Will these hits hold on to the top spots? We'll report on that and all the chart action this week -- on American Top 40.
