1) ARETHA'S SECOND POP #1 (:26)

This is Casey Kasem. For all her tremendous success for almost 25 years, Aretha Franklin has only had one number one song on the pop chart...her 1967 classic, "RESPECT". Aretha's latest smash "FREEWAY OF LOVE", drove up two notches to number three last week in the countdown. Will the Queen of Soul zoom to the top of the official Billboard chart this week, with her second pop number one? We'll find out on American Top 40.

2) THE POWER AT NUMBER ONE (:20)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. Last week, the number one song on the official Billboard chart, for a second week in a row, was "THE POWER OF LOVE" by Huey Lewis and the News. Can "THE POWER" keep them on top when there's a lot of heat from underneath coming from "ST. ELMO'S FIRE" by John Parr, at number two? We'll find out and report all the action on American Top 40.

3) BOSS IN THE U.S.A. (:18)

Hi, this is Casey Kasem. The hottest rocker in the U.S.A. may return to the Top 40 this week. Bruce Springsteen has just released "I'M GOIN' DOWN", single number six from his multi-platinum album, "BORN IN THE U.S.A.". We'll be looking for the boss to hit the official Billboard survey on American Top 40.

4) DEBUTS LINED UP 'N READY (:26)

This is Casey Kasem. Some hot new hits are lined up to debut this week on American Top 40. Among the top contenders for the countdown are: Sting's "FORTRESS AROUND YOUR HEART", Laura Branigan's "SPANISH EDDIE", UB40 with "I GOT YOU BABE", and a duet by rock 'n roll legends Mick Jagger and David Bowie, the classic "DANCING IN THE STREET." We'll see who debuts as we report all the official Billboard chart action on American Top 40.
